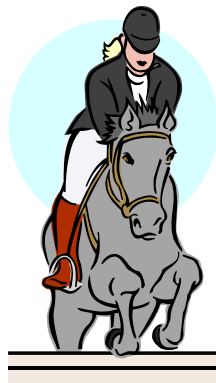

Riders must be 12 years and under on the 1st of January and be on a pony 13.2hh/138cm and under to be eligible for this class

Height: 60-65cm first round

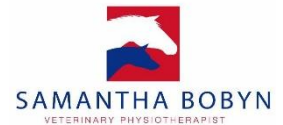

Show rules: 1. Trentvalley Riding Club/ Event Centre Committee shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, injury or death to any persons, property or animals at any time whilst on the show ground whether competing or not.2.Trentvalley Riding Club/ Event Centre Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person at their discretion without explanation.3. Trentvalley Riding Club/ Event Centre Committee reserve the right to cancel, alter, amend, split or amalgamate any class, or substitute any judge at any time.4. The judge's decision is final.5. Hard hats to the current BSI standard must be worn by all riders when mounted, and by all competitors under the age of fourteen when showing in-hand.6. Any person behaving inappropriately or using bad language to anyone on the show ground will be disqualified and asked to leave the show ground.7. Any person found abusing any horse or pony will be disqualified and asked to leave the show ground.8. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.9. Correct and appropriate riding attire must be worn at all times whilst competing.10. No standing or waiting in the warm up area. Collecting ring and car park should be used for those not warming up.11. No person is to be in the arena whilst the judge is course building, until they are told they can walk the course.12. Warm up jumps are jumped with the red wing on the right hand side.13. If there are any horses with a green tail ribbon, the horse is young or inexperienced.14. If there are any horses with a red tail ribbon, the horse kicks.15. Please ensure you poo pick your car park area using the trailer provided to help keep Trentvalley clean and tidy.16.Horses and ponies must not be left unattended tied to horseboxes (unless inside the horse box or trailer) 17.If a competitor competes on more than one mount, it is the competitor's responsibility to space classes accordingly.
